Expectations for Chaperones

In order to protect your students and the art on display at MASS MoCA, we expect that all chaperones, both parents and teachers, will adhere to the following guidelines:

- All school students must be accompanied by a chaperone at all times with a ratio of at least 1 chaperone for every 10 students.
- If you wish for your high school students to tour on their own, please discuss your plans with the Education Coordinator when you book your visit.
- All chaperones must be at least 18 years of age.
- Chaperones must follow the requests of any museum employee, including security guards, box office workers and any other personnel.

Before your visit, please go over these basic behavior guidelines with your students:

- All students must be accompanied by an adult at all times
- No running or skipping is permitted in the galleries
- No eating, drinking or gum chewing allowed in the galleries
- All students are expected to be courteous to other visitors, and follow the requests of all museum staff
- No yelling, screaming or cursing
- Unless given specific permission by a staff member or posted sign, you may not touch any of the art on display
